- OSHA Inspection Overview
- WHY NOW?
- OSHA has put an increased emphasis on industries where there is a risk from combustible dust. "Combustible Dust National Emphasis Program"
- Increase in OAHA violations deemed "serious", up to \$7,000/day
- Decrease in willingness to negotiate penalties

Insurance Concerns

• WHY NOW?

- Large losses have led to a decrease in carriers willing to *meaningfully* insure pellet operations
- Property and business interruption policies have had increase in premiums and decrease in coverage

- Have all records in office and shop
- 300 logs
- MSDS sheets
- Safety handbook (we can provide guidance)
- Other documents, dust sampling

Sit back down and review findings

• Problem

- Wood Pellet industry has a relatively small amount of actuarial data to base rates on with little underwriting expertise
- Carriers have suffered some large property losses especially due to fire/explosions
- Riskiest areas are seen to be in dryers and hammer milling equipment
