


# What's Driving Interest in Pellet Heating, and Policymaker Attention?

- High energy costs
- Fossil energy price volatility, e.g. propane, natural gas
- National attention on export pellet growth
- Policy attention on rural America, income gap
- Increased understanding of vital necessity of good markets for low grade wood
- Reducing fuel loads in regions of high forest fire risk

- **Rebates for pellet appliances** MA, MD, ME, NH, NY
