





U.S. Hearth Appliance Shipments in 2011




- Cordwood 197,181

Between 2010 and 2011 . . .

- <u>Cordwood</u> appliance shipments decreased 15%
 - From 230,948 to 197,181
- <u>Gas</u> appliance shipments decreased 12%
 - From 650,911 to 573,468
- <u>Pellet</u> appliance shipments increased 41%
 - From 44,288 to 62,451

Electric hearth appliance shipments increased 11% between 2010 and 2011


Overall, industry declined 10% between 2010 and 2011




Since 1998 . . .

- <u>Cordwood</u> appliance shipments decreased 70%
 – From 652,500 to 197,181
- <u>Gas</u> appliance shipments decreased 64%
 - From 1,611,750 to 573,468
- Pellet appliance shipments increased 83%
 - From 34,000 to 62,451




Total U.S. Hearth Appliance Shipments

1998--2011




U.S. Hearth Appliance Shipments 1998--2011




U.S. Pellet Appliance Shipments 1992--2011




U.S. Pellet Appliance Shipments 2011






Pellet Stoves vs. Freestanding Stoves



% of Reps Who Feel Pellet Appliance Sales are Up Compared to a Year Ago Quarterly--June 2000 through January 2011




Measurement Scale Changed April 2006

Central Heating Systems Fueled with Biomass Fuels

- Program started 2Q09
- Two categories collected:
 - Central Heating Systems fueled with Pellets
 - Central Heating Systems fueled with Cordwood/Wood Chips

Pellet Appliance Observations

- Pellet Appliance Shipments and Sales are the most <u>volatile</u> in the hearth industry
- When the consumers view the price of <u>heating their home to be expensive</u>, then sales and shipments dramatically increase
- When the consumers view the price of <u>heating their home to be</u> <u>reasonable</u>, then sales and <u>shipments are much less robust</u>
